1. The meeting was called to order.
  - a. Previous Minutes:
    - Minutes from the previous Board meeting were approved with two corrections. (Montante, Hutchens)
  - b. Treasurer's Report:
    - Presented by the Board President in absentia for the Treasurer. See attached.
    - There was a balance of \$9484.85
    - All members have paid this year's dues except for *East Stroudsburg*.
    - It was questioned why there is a \$5.00 savings balance. It is required by the type of account we have.
    - It was asked whether our accounts are interest bearing. They are not due to tax issues.
    - Treasurer's report was approved. (Hutchens, Montante)

2. Spring 2011 Conference at Shippensburg

3. Spring 2012 Conference at Millersville
  - Important dates:
    - Submissions for peer review deadline: February 10
    - Non-reviewed submission deadline (abstracts, birds-of-a-feather, etc.): February 24
    - Programming team registration deadline: March 5
    - Acceptance notification of peer-reviewed papers: March 5
    - Camera-ready copies of manuscripts: March 12
    - Registration deadline: March 12
    - Conference: March 30, 31
  - Call for Papers is expected to be out by Thanksgiving.
  - Keynote speaker: Jennifer Chu-Carroll, IBM Watson development team.
  - Theme: AI-related. Millersville will provide specifics at the next meeting.
  - Editorial Board: Dave Mooney (chair), Lisa Kovalchick, Bob Montante.
  - Questions from Millersville:
    - How many rooms should be reserved?
    - If publishers are invited, how much should they be expected to contribute? \$100 - \$150? \$200?
  - Changing the basic conference schedule as per the last meeting's discussion was debated. Various possibilities were considered:
    - Moving the general meeting before Saturday's lunch.
    - Running the programming contest from 10 to 1.
    - Starting talks at 8 AM Saturday.
    - Having student talks Saturday morning, faculty talks Friday afternoon.
  - There were pros and cons for every suggested change. Ultimately, it was decided that these decisions should be left to the host school. Millersville will take the suggestions under advisement and present their decisions at the January board meeting.
  - It was asked whether West Chester (Afrand) will set up a *Google* account for the conference as she has done for the past two.

  - *Slippery Rock* will continue maintaining the site, Maria Harrington taking over for Bernie Zhou. The site needs to be updated, especially re new members.
